

Where in Old Malden Answers:

- 1 The sleeping beauty house with wisteria up to roof is in Avondale Avenue.
- 2 The 'peacock palm' (Richard's naming) is in Church Road, a few houses on the church's side from the turning for Brockenhurst Ave.
- 3 Is in the church yard, near the lychgate.
- 4 The curved road is behind what was the Coop, in Idmiston Road.
- 5 Electricity substation next to Church Hall.
- 6 Hollow tree in church yard, near war memorial
- 7 Steps up to railway, between bridge and shops.
- 8 Window over one of the shops at the Plough
- 9 On lychgate
- 10 The Vicar's private gate for short cut between church and vicarage
- 11 A corner of Malden Parochial School, seen from road outside
- 12 The old toilets by Plough car park.
