“The Friends of St. John the Baptist Church, Keynsham” was inaugurated in 1990. It is a Registered Charity, and its purpose is to raise money for the maintenance of Keynsham’s historic Parish Church. This involves the repair, restoration, improvement and adornment of the Church building and its contents. As at 2020, “The Friends” has been able to give over £58,000 towards this work.

St. John’s has been standing on this prominent site in the town for almost 750 years. For all that time it has been a place of faithful Christian witness, with its regular weekly pattern of worship, as well as the annual round of special services such as at Christmas, Easter and Remembrance Sunday etc. For so many families, St. John’s has been the setting for joyful celebrations – weddings and baptisms – and for those sad times, the saying of good-byes at funerals.

St. John’s is a major venue in Keynsham for community events. The building has excellent acoustics, and hosts a variety of evening and lunch-time concerts. In the last few years, many thousands of people have been drawn to our Christmas Tree and Flower Festivals.

St. John’s has been handed down to us through the generations, and it is our duty to pass it on to the next generation with everything in good order. So, whatever your interest in St. John’s may be – as a House of Prayer, as a building of historic and architectural interest, or as a place you associate with a particular family occasion – do please consider supporting the work of “The Friends”.
