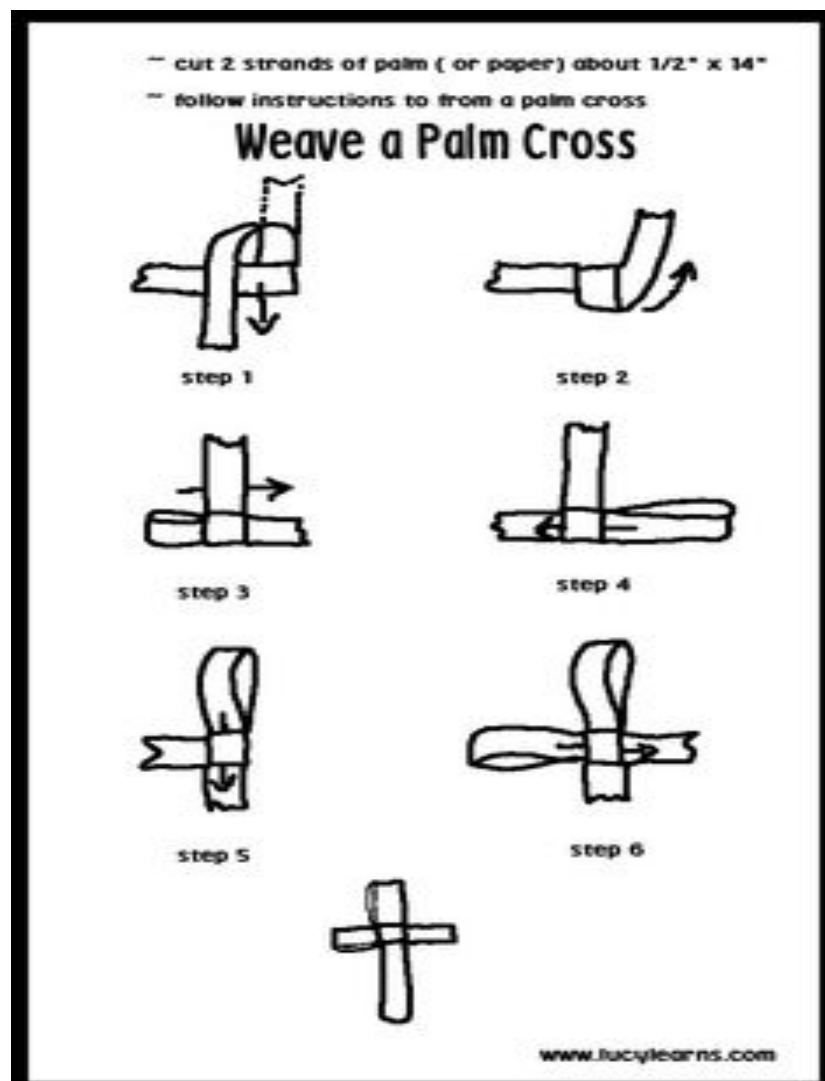


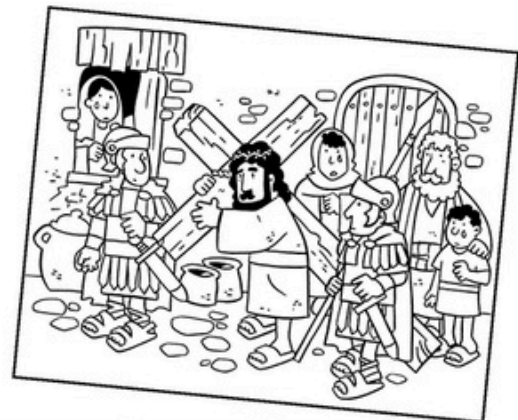


Children & Young People's catch up....

Retelling the Easter story with eggs.

Gather six plastic eggs, each a different color. Place the following items inside, one item per egg: breadcrumb, paper cross, strip of cloth, rock and a sweet. One egg will remain empty. As you tell the Resurrection story, let your child open the eggs. Explain each item in the following order:

1. Bread crumb: Jesus ate dinner with His friends. (Luke22:14-15)
2. Cross: The next day, Jesus died on the Cross. (John19:17-18)
3. Strip of cloth: He was wrapped in cloth and placed in a tomb.
(John 19:40)
4. Rock: A stone was placed in front of the tomb. (Matthew27:59-60)
5. Empty egg: Jesus' friends came to the tomb and saw the stone had been moved. The tomb was empty! (Luke 24:1-3)
6. Sweet: Jesus is alive. That's the sweet surprise of Easter. (Matthew 28:5-6)


Jesus washed the feet of his disciples before they shared bread and wine at the Last Supper.

MAUNDY THURSDAY




On Sunday morning Mary and Mary Magdalene went to visit the tomb where Jesus was buried. The rock in front of the tomb had been rolled away and the tomb was empty. Jesus had risen again!

EASTER SUNDAY



Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. The crowds were excited and waved palm leaves to greet him. Palm leaves and cloaks were placed on the ground as an act of worship for Jesus to ride over.

PALM SUNDAY



Jesus was arrested and sentenced to death. He wore a crown of thorns on his head and carried his wooden cross through the streets. Jesus was nailed to the cross and died that day. He was buried in a tomb.
