WEEK 1: LOOKING UP: OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD.

Day 1: CONNECT WITH GOD RELATIONALLY

OUR FATHER, WHO ART IN HEAVEN.

God isn't interested in us practicing religion; instead, He desires a relationship with us. God has adopted us as His children and loves for us to call Him our Father. Starting our prayer time acknowledging our relationship with God is powerful for us and delights Him as well.

So, you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when He adopted you as His own children. Now we call Him, "Abba, Father." - ROMANS 8:15 NLT

Proclaim your intimate relationship with God, addressing Him as your Heavenly Father and thanking Him that you are His child.

PRAYER: "Father, I come to You in prayer today thankful that I am Your child. I know I am a sinner, but You have forgiven me and adopted me as Your own, and I am so grateful to call you my Heavenly Father. Thank you for loving me. I love you."

Day 2: WORSHIP HIS NAME

HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

God loves when we worship Him, and there is power in His Name. Here is a list of some of His Names to help us worship Him specifically and personally:

God is Righteousness – He makes us clean God is Sanctifier – He has called us and set us apart

God is Healer – He heals all our diseases God is Banner of Victory – He defeated our enemies

God is Shepherd – He speaks to us and leads us

God is Peace – He is our peace in every storm God is Provider – He supplies all of our needs

The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run into it and is safe. - PROVERBS 18:10 ESV

Speak God's names out loud. When we proclaim who He is, we not only worship Him, but we also remind ourselves how powerful and great our God is.

PRAYER:

"God, I am in awe of You. Your Name is a strong tower, a place of protection and safety for me. I praise You as my Healer, my Shepherd, and my Banner of Victory. You are my Peace, my Provider, my Righteousness, and my Sanctifier. Your Name is great, and I worship You."

Day 3: PUTTING GOD FIRST

YOUR KINGDOM COME. YOUR WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN.

Part of being a child of God is caring about what He cares about. We know His will is perfect, and we acknowledge His wisdom and sovereignty when we pray His agenda first.

He will always give you all you need from day to day if you will make the Kingdom of God your primary concern. LUKE 12:31 TLB

Spend time focusing on His priorities for your life

- Ask God to help you put him first in your life.
- What areas of your life do you need to surrender to God?

PRAYER:

"God, I recognize there is no better plan on earth than Yours, and I pray for Your will to be done in my life (name the areas of your life where you need more of God's presence today) and in our world. This world is lost and needs You desperately, and I pray for every person to know You as their personal Lord and Saviour. I pray for the leaders in my life (pray specifically over parents, spiritual leaders, government leaders, employers, and any other leaders in your life), that You would give them supernatural wisdom and discernment as they lead. Give them a revelation of Your will and Your purpose for them. I give my life to You again today; have Your way in my life! Anything You want to do in me or through me, I will do. I ask today for wisdom and clarity as You show me my next steps."

Day 4: YOU CAN DEPEND ON HIM FOR EVERYTHING

"GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD'

God promises to supply all our needs, and He wants us to come to Him with our problems, needs, and desires and to trust Him to provide.

I look up to the mountains—does my help come from there? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth! - PSALM 121:1-2 NLT

Ask God for what you need today. It may help to write down the concerns weighing on your mind or the desires of your heart. You can bring your worries or desires to God, trusting Him enough by handing them over to Him fully! It may help to open your hands before God to physically show your surrender to Him. Problems can either be ours or God's; they can't be both.

PRAYER:

"Father, I acknowledge that everything I need today will come from You. You made the heavens and the earth; You are more than capable of handling any situation I'm dealing with, so I give it to You completely (specifically talk to God about what is on your mind and heart right now and give it to Him). I look to You to help me, sustain me, and give me Your peace. Remind me of Your hope and power today. Thank You in advance for taking care of my needs."

DAY 5: GOD IS A FORGIVING GOD.

"FORIGVE OUR DEBTS, AS WE FORGIVE OUR DEBTORS"

God has offered us complete forgiveness, and we can receive it at any time. When we turn away from our sins and receive His forgiveness, our hearts are more prepared to forgive others as well.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 JOHN 1:9

Thank God for his forgiveness, that he has forgiven you all of your sin. Ask God to check your heart and life and show you areas where you might need to ask for forgiveness from Him. Then, it is your turn to forgive those who have offended you. We can even choose to forgive people in advance. Ask God to forgive you and to help you forgive others.

PRAYER:

"God, thank You so much for offering me the gift of forgiveness. Show me any areas in my life that I need to bring before You in order to receive forgiveness and healing. I confess that I have been struggling with sin (talk to God about any areas of sin in your life), and I know that You want me to be clean again. Please forgive me for my sin. Thank You for showing me unfailing grace. As You have so freely forgiven me, I also want to freely forgive others. Please help me let go of all of my offenses. I release to You those who have hurt me, and I trust You to handle those situations according to Your perfect will."

DAY 6: THE BATTLE IS THE LORD'S

"AND DO NOT LEAD US INTO TEMPTATION BUT DELIVER US FROM THE EVIL ONE."

Spiritual battles can seem difficult to understand, but the Bible makes it very clear that we have an enemy who has come to steal, kill, and destroy our lives (John 10:10). As we pray, we take our stand against the enemy and fight from a place of victory through Jesus as we're empowered by His Holy Spirit. There is power in God's Word, and every lie the enemy has told us can be replaced with God's truth. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. - EPHESIANS 6:12 NIV

By recognizing that the enemy wants to destroy you, you can shed light on his lies and claim God's truth over your life. Ask God to show you any lies you're believing or areas of spiritual battles happening in your life. Ask Him to expose the enemy and to help you understand and receive His truth. Simply speaking the name of Jesus has great power in the spiritual realm. The Bible tells us in James 4:7 that if we resist the devil, he will flee from us. Through prayer, we can resist him and walk forward in freedom.

PRAYER:

"God, I recognize that my struggles today aren't against the people or circumstances around me, but against the enemy. Please help me to see how the enemy is lying to me. Help me recognize his lies, take them captive, and make all of my thoughts obedient to the truth of Your Word (list out any specific areas God shows you where you have believed a lie that needs to be replaced with His truth). While the enemy wants to destroy me, I know that You came to give me life to the fullest. I speak the name of Jesus over my life and declare that no weapon formed against me will prosper. I don't have to fear the enemy because the One who is in me is greater than the one who is in the world."

DAY 7: OUR GOD IS ABLE

"FOR YOURS IS THE KINGDOM AND THE POWER AND THE GLORY FOREVER."

God is more than able to move in every situation, and ending our prayer time claiming His authority and power focuses our minds on the truth and hope of who He is and what He can do.

Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for You. - JEREMIAH 32:17 NIV Remind yourself of God's limitless power and then return to praising Him and declaring your faith in Him:

- "Yours is the Kingdom" all authority belongs to You
- "Yours is the Power" all might flows from You
- "Yours is the Glory" Your victory will be complete

PRAYER:

"Father God, nothing is too hard for You! Through Your great power, all things are possible. All authority is Yours, all might is Yours, and I know that Your victory will be complete. You are amazing, and I worship You. I praise You for Your power and presence in my life. You are my God, and You are worthy of all praise."

WEEK 2: LOOKING IN: THE CHURCH - OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH EACH OTHER

DAY 8: UNITY FOR THE CHURCH

I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me. JOHN 17:20-23

- Pray for God's love to flow through our church and that our love for one another will be a testimony of God's grace and mercy to those who do not know God.
- Pray for the healing of relationships and for people within the church to encounter the presence and love of God in their lives.
- Pray for people in the church that God puts on your heart.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide you in what you will be praying for.

DAY 9: GOD'S WILL FOR HIS CHURCH

So, we have not stopped praying for you since we first heard about you. We ask God to give you complete knowledge of his will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding. ¹⁰ Then the way you live will always honour and please the Lord, and your lives will produce every kind of good fruit. All the while, you will grow as you learn to know God better and better.

We also pray that you will be strengthened with all his glorious power so you will have all the endurance and patience you need. May you be filled with joy, [a] 12 always thanking the Father. He has enabled you to share in the inheritance that belongs to his people, who live in the light. 13 For he has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of his dear Son.

PRAY FOR GOD'S WILL WITHIN THE CHURCH

In Colossians 1, the Apostle Paul displays his heart for the church by praying that the people within the church be filled with the knowledge of God's will, so that they can live for Jesus. Colossians 1:9–13:

- Pray that we would understand God's plans and His will for our lives and our church.
- Pray for the current ministries with Dundee Elim Church, and that God will release people to start new ministries.
- Pray for the leaders within Dundee Elim Church and also the raising up of new leaders in the church
- Pray that people will surrender their lives to God's plan and will.
- Pray that people will grow in their relationship with God, knowing God better.

DAY 10: PRAY FOR THE HOLY SPIRIT TO MOVE IN THE CHURCH

I have not stopped thanking God for you. I pray for you constantly, ¹⁷ asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, to give you spiritual wisdom^[a] and insight so that you might grow in your knowledge of God. ¹⁸ I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance.^[b]

¹⁹ I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him. This is the same mighty power ²⁰ that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honour at God's right hand in the heavenly realms. Ephesians 1:16-20

In Ephesians 1 and 3, the Apostle Paul prays that God the Father would give the Spirit of God to the people within the church. He prays that God would strengthen them in the Spirit, so that Jesus dwells in their hearts and they are rooted in the love of Christ. Here's Ephesians 1:16–20:

- Spend time thanking God for His blessings on your life.
- Thank God for the grace and mercy that he showers on us each day.
- Pray that people will be grounded in God's Word and experience His love in powerful ways.
- Pray for times of refreshing and that people will be filled with the Holy Spirit as we meet together.
- Ask God to fill you with His Holy Spirit as you pray.
- Pray that the church will become more aware of the presence and power of God in the church.

DAY 11: A COMMUNITY OF BELIEVERS

All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper^[a]), and to prayer.

⁴³ A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. ⁴⁴ And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. ACTS 2:42-44.

The believers were committed to 'being the church' that God had called and equipped them to be. This needed each person to be intentional about their devotion to God and to the other believers. It was by this love for one another that they caught the attention of those who didn't know Jesus, and the result was that the church grew.

- Pray for an environment of love and acceptance in the church
- Pray for a deeper devotion to God and an increase of care for each other.
- Pray that we will be filled with 'awe' as we worship God together.
- Pray for the ministries within Dundee Elim Church. Pray for a release of workers for the various ministries and for new ministries to be released.

DAY 12. PROTECTION FOR THE CHURCH

Put on all of God's armour so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. ¹² For we^[a] are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. ¹³ Therefore, put on every piece of God's armour so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. ¹⁴ Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armour of God's righteousness. ¹⁵ For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. ^[b] ¹⁶ In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. ^[c] ¹⁷ Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸ Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere. Ephesians 6:11-18

We are in a spiritual battle and so we need to fight with spiritual weapons. God has equipped us with everything we need to face the raging battle that faces the church.

- Pray for God's protection on His church.
- Pray that people will recognise that there is a spiritual battle.
- Pray that we will be strengthened to stand firm in God.

BE DISCERNING Be aware of the devil's strategies and schemes. 2 Corinthians 2:11

"For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the whole armour of God" Ephesians 6: 16

BE DILIGENT put on the armour of God daily.....
"Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong". 1 Corinthians 16:13

BE DISCIPLINED read God's Word, be filled with the Holy Spirit, Pray, worship, witness, etc.....

"Be hospitable, one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined. Titus 1:8

DAY 13: HE FORGIVES ALL OUR SINS AND HEALS ALL OUR DISEASES.

Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all His benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. - PSALM 103:2-5

Our God is a God of miracles. Just as we read about in the Bible, we still see Him perform miraculous healing today. He is our healer, and we can confidently approach Him asking for healing for ourselves or someone we know. In faith, ask God for healing. Proclaim His power and goodness, believing and trusting Him to take care of you or those you're praying to be healed.

- Pray for God's healing power to be present when we meet together.
- Pray for those who are sick in the church and those in your family.
- Thank Jesus for his sacrifice on the cross so that we can experience healing.

Declare this prayer.

"Father, in the Name of Jesus, I come before You asking for healing (name yourself or someone you are praying to experience healing). My hope is in You as our healer. I believe You are able to do this. You are the God who heals, and I believe every knee will bow to You including the name of (name disease or disorder).

Thank You, Jesus, for dying on the cross so that we can receive healing. You say that You forgive our sins and heal our diseases, and I praise You for this. Thank You that the Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead lives in us. I stand in faith believing for healing for (yourself or someone you're praying for). Nothing is impossible for You, God! Give us peace and direction as You work in our lives. In Jesus Name, Amen."

DAY 14: TRANSFORMED LIVES

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. Romans 12:2

God wants us to live our lives free from all that holds us back in our relationship with Him. His desire is that we will become mature in the things of God and have a deeper more intimate relationship with Him. In February, we will be taking the church through 'Emotionally Healthy Spirituality' and journeying towards becoming healthier in our spiritual and emotional lives. If we are going to see our church healthy, then we need to become spiritually and emotionally healthy.

I encourage you to be praying about going through this course for your own life. Give yourselves to the 8 weeks of the course and discover the things God wants to do in you and through you.

- Pray that people in the church will get involved with the course.
- Pray that God will prepare people's hearts for encounters with Him through this course.
- Pray that God's power will be evident as we journey together in this course.
- Pray that God will soften hearts of people as they prepare for the course.
- Pray that people will have an understanding of what Holy Spirit is saying to them through the course.

Spend time thanking God for His faithfulness as this 2nd week of prayer come to an end.

WEEK 3: LOOKING OUT: OUR WORLD - OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THOSE THAT DO NOT YET HAVE A RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS.

DAY 15. GOD WANTS ALL PEOPLE TO BE SAVED.

Many people think Christianity is just another religion. They only see God through the lens of the organization and institution of the church. But God didn't come to build an organization. He came to have a relationship with His children.

The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by Him we cry, "Abba, Father." - ROMANS 8:15 NIV

God wants His beloved sons and daughters to come home, to return to Him and the family of God. Praying for people to have personal encounters with the living God makes a huge difference.

- Pray that lost people will understand how much God loves them and cares for them.
- Pray that they will come to a meaningful relationship with God.
- Pray that people's eyes will be opened to the truth of the Gospel.

The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

2 CORINTHIANS 4:4 NIV

- Pray that those who once walked with God will return to Him.
- Pray for those in your family, friends, neighbours who don't know Jesus as their Lord and Saviour.

DAY 16: ALL WILL KNOW JESUS

"For The Son Of Man Came To Seek And Save Those Who Are Lost."

Luke 19:10 (NIt)

Lord, I know Your heart is for no one to be lost without You. Today I bring before You (pray specifically for those in your life who need to come
to know Jesus) and ask that You would continue drawing them to You through
Your kindness as Your Word says.
I know You would do anything for even just one person to come to know You so I'm asking You to keep pursuing's heart. Use me to be an extension of Your love in their lives. I pray Your Holy Spirit would reveal to them their need for a leader and forgiver. I pray they would have a spiritual awakening and thirst for You and what only You can give them.
Open their ears to hear Your voice. I am thankful You are a God of transformation and life-change. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

 Parent & Toddler Groups, Outreach Groups, Teenager Ministries etc
- Ask God if there is a particular ministry into the community that He wants you to step out and get started.
- Or, pray about what organisation God wants you to serve in the community.

Day 18: PRAYING FOR MY COMMUNITY

My Community is

Most important of all, continue to show deep love for each other, for love covers a multitude of sins. Cheerfully share your home with those who need a meal or a place to stay. - Pray for unbelievers to be saved.
- Pray for a spiritual awakening in the city and the surrounding communities
- Pray for the other churches in the city. Pray for unity between pastors and churches
- Pray for families. Pray that Jesus will bring healing and restoration to families within your community and the city.
- Pray for children and youth to discover the love and power of God in their lives.
- Pray for the local politicians and decision makers across the city. Pray for wisdom to make wise decisions and the boldness and courage to govern with integrity, justice and mercy.

Day 19: STEPPING OUT IN THE PURPOSES OF GOD.

David served the purpose of God in his own generation. Acts 13:36

Despite his weaknesses, God made David into a great king for the glory of God. David is also described as 'A man after God's own heart'

The challenge for us is to face the opportunities that God has for us in our generation. We don't know if these are the best times or the worst of times, all we know is that they are our time. This is our time to shine for Jesus and serve his purposes in this current generation in which we live.

What has God put in your heart to do? Step out in faith and like David, serve the purposes of God in your generation.

- Pray for a clarity in hearing God, and what he is calling us to do as a church.
- Pray for the plans of the church to step out in faith and begin ministries that will serve the community.

Some things we are thinking about are: 'Parent and toddler group, evangelistic events on a Sunday evening.

 Pray that God will put things on your heart with ways to reach out to the city. For example: Praying in the city, prayer walking, running a children's holiday club during the holiday breaks, lunch club for the elderly, lunches for kids during the summer holiday. These are just some ideas, what is God putting on your heart.

My Thoughts and Ideas for stepping out are:_		

Day 20: BLESSING THE CITY

You take care of the earth and water it, making it rich and fertile. The river of God has plenty of water; it provides a bountiful harvest of grain, for you have ordered it so. You drench the ploughed ground with rain, melting the clods and levelling the ridges. You soften the earth with showers and bless its abundant crops. You crown the year with a bountiful harvest; even the hard pathways overflow with abundance. Psalm 65:9-11

God wants to bless our city. His desire is that if the land prospers, so too will our communities prosper. He is the good Father who loves to bless his people.

Spend some time blessing the city, blessing your community, blessing your neighbours. There is power in blessing, and as you have heard said many times, "You are blessed to be a blessing"

So, pray some prayers of blessing over your community, over the city and over the church, and let's not forget, you can pray blessing over your own life and the life of your family. Some examples are:

- I bless my community to prosper, to know peace and to know God
- I bless that families in my community with the strength and provision they need to flourish as a family
- I bless my community / my neighbours, to know and experience the love of God in their lives.

Spend some time also, thinking of practical ways you can bless someone in your neighbourhood. It could be giving them a card, a cake or box of biscuits, offering to do their shopping etc.

Day 21: THE WAY OF HEALING FOR THE CITY.

Thank you for praying over these past 21 days. Know that God has heard every prayer offered to him. As we end 21 days of prayer, I want to finish with verses that you are familiar with. These are powerful verses and tells us what God requires to see healing come to our nation, to our city and our communities.

Then one night the Lord appeared to Solomon and said,

"I have heard your prayer and have chosen this Temple as the place for making sacrifices. ¹³ At times I might shut up the heavens so that no rain falls, or command grasshoppers to devour your crops, or send plagues among you. ¹⁴ Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land. ¹⁵ My eyes will be open and my ears attentive to every prayer made in this place. ¹⁶ For I have chosen this Temple and set it apart to be holy—a place where my name will be honoured forever. I will always watch over it, for it is dear to my heart. ² Chronicles 7:12-16

Spend some time meditating on these verses and ask Holy Spirit to show you the truth of these verses for your live.

- Come in humility before God to seek his face.
- Turn from any ways in your life that are not God's ways.
- Spend time thanking God for his grace and mercy, and for the healing of the city and communities around you.
- Thank God for these past 21 days that have seen many people pray.
- Thank God for 2024, and that you will discover all that God wants to do in you and through you.
- Pray for God's grace for healing to be poured out over our churches.
