WISDOM GROUPS: Luke 3: 1-17

WISDOM REFLECTIONS

This week we look at John the Baptist as his feast day is June 24th and he is the patron saint of Penzance on the basis that the local geography looks like a head and Penzance literally means holy headland – and John the Baptist suffered the terrible fate of being executed for criticising the morals of the governor.

1. Picture yourself as one of the crowd listening to John. Imagine you are there beside the River Jordan. How does his words impact on you? Luke tells us that the people were 'filled with expectation'. What kind of expectation would being there have put into your heart?
2. Look at John's teaching in verses 10 to 14 and think about the other things you might know about his preaching. What words would you find to describe his style of evangelising?

John comes over as a man who would not compromise. He would not temper his message to win the sympathy of his hearers. He has not taken advice from the local PR firm!

He was blunt with the Roman soldiers, the Pharisees and Herod himself and paid the price. How do you feel about his approach?

Do you admire his cast iron conviction? Or are you concerned by an inflexible dogmatism?

Can you recall a time when you have felt it was right to challenge someone?
