E-WAVES PROJECT

WISDOM GROUPS: SEA SUNDAY JOHN 21 : 1- 14

For our Sea Sunday reading we hear of an encounter that the disciples of Jesus had with Jesus after his Rising from the dead. They have gone back to their day job of fishing in the Sea of Galilee. Jesus appears to them on the sea shore after showing them where they can make a great catch.

Peter and the others did not immediately recognise that the stranger on the shore was Jesus (A little like the two disciples who walked to Emmaus and did not at first realise the man who joined them on the road was Jesus until they shared a meal together). Is that experience of God being present but not seen and not recognised initially one that you have known ? If so, what was your response when the penny dropped ? Was it a jump into the water and swim straight away ? Or follow behind in the boat ?

Picture yourself in the boat after a night's fishing in which the disciples have caught nothing. How do you feel ? Has there been a time in your life when you have felt like this? When you emerged from this on the other side was there any sense that God had been with you and seen you through ? Were you able to say as one of them said 'It is the Lord!' ?

What do you make of the exact number of fish 153 ? What if at the time of the gospel being written this was the total number of fish species known to humans ? Would that convey a message? What might the significance be in the detail we are told that 'the net was not torn'. How does that make you feel about being part of God's family?

In the Creation Story in Genesis 1 we read And God said, 'Let the waters bring forth swarms of living creatures.....So God created the great sea monsters and every living creature that moves, of every kind, with which the waters swarm.

Jacques Cousteau said "The sea, once it casts its spell, holds one in its net of wonder forever." Think back to David Attenborough's The Blue Planet or a similar TV programme. Share in the group a fish or sea creature shown there that led you into a deeper sense of awe and wonder of God's creation.

Planet Earth has five great oceans and 113 seas. They represent 72 percent of the surface of the globe, and together they've been an endless source of inspiration for humankind. Yet The Blue Planet included dramatic images of vast islands of plastic floating on the ocean.
