PLEASE REMEMBER IN YOUR PRAYERS ...

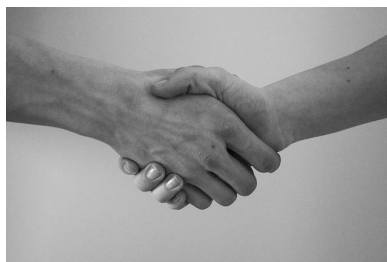
