A is for Angel

- Wooden craft sticks (You need two regular and one small craft stick for each angel craft you make. Glue together to form a letter A.)
- White card/paper_(Cut a circle for face and glue to your angel at the point of the letter A. Trace your child's hand onto white paper and cut out for wings then glue to each side of letter in the back so that fingers stick out.)
- Glue
- Black marker (to draw face)
- Silver pipe cleaner (to make halo - glue to the back of the letter A so that it sticks up above your angel's head.)
