Role: To support and enhance the Worship at All Saints Church through the medium of flowers, under the guidance of the Flower Team Co-ordinator

Role Requirements:

To be: To be a person of integrity, who serves in a gracious, Christ-like manner

To do:

- To take a turn/s on the flower rota, and to be responsible for arranging the flowers in church approximately twice a year, either by giving a donation, or as follows:
- Purchase the flowers and arrange the display on a Friday or Saturday
- Be available to help as part of a team to do the displays for major events – Christmas, Easter or Harvest Festival
- Be available to help as part of a team for preparing the flowers for weddings/funerals as required
- Adhere to the All Saints risk assessment for Church users
- To attend an annual meeting with the Flower Team Co-ordinator/s, for support and supervision
