- To demonstrate respect for and loyalty to the Incumbent, in their role as the spiritual leader of All Saints; and respect for the authority of the PCC, as the appointed governing body at All Saints
- To attend 3 Small Group leaders' meetings each year, for support and supervision by the Pastoral Vision Group Chair
- To read, adhere to and promote all aspects of the All Saints Safeguarding Policy (www.cofeguildford.org.uk/safeguardingpolicy), including recruitment and training requirements; and all other Policies of All Saints Church.
