

Role description for Youth Leaders at All Saints

Role:

To organise and lead youth group meetings to provide fun and fellowship in a safe environment where the young people of All Saints can explore and develop their faith, whilst giving them the opportunity to bring friends.

Role Requirements:

To be:

To be called by God and approved by All Saints church, to be a Youth Leader in this parish. To be a person who leads in a gracious, Christ-like manner; and who treats each young person with respect and dignity, as a unique individual created in the image of God. To be a person whose own life of prayer and worship sets an example for young people to follow.

To do all the following:

- To attend youth group planning meetings, contributing to discussion, and seeking wisdom from God, within the remit of the group.
- To help with organising youth group meetings one Sunday evening per month, usually the 3rd Sunday
- To attend services at All Saints regularly, and have a good understanding of the worshipping life of the church
- To find and use appropriate resources to enable the young people to grow in their understanding of the Christian faith
- To respect the role of the Incumbent as the spiritual leader of All Saints; and the PCC, as the appointed governing body at All Saints
- To be a member of the Youth Group Team; and to receive appropriate support and supervision by the Children and Young Peoples Vision Group Chair at least three times per year.
- To read, adhere to and promote all aspects of the All Saints Safeguarding Policy including recruitment and training requirements; and all other relevant Policies of All Saints Church
