

CAWTHORNE CHURCH APPEAL COMMEMORATIVE FLOWER POT



Local businessman Gordon Harrison, former Cawthorne schoolboy and resident, and owner of William Blyth (Handmade Clay Roof Tile and Pottery Manufacturers' since 1840) has freely donated to the Church a series of 100 specially designed terracotta flowerpots made by Gabriel Nichols based at the Humber Bridge Garden Centre over at Barton upon Humber, North Lincolnshire. These pots are to be sold by the Church with 100% of the proceeds being returned to the Church. These hand thrown and unique clay flower pots are individually numbered with a commemorative rose, embossed Cawthorne lettering and then fired in a traditional coal fired kiln producing a stunning terracotta frost proof garden pot.
