



### Protocol for Safe Worship during the Coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic

To make worship as safe as possible the following protocol must be observed:

- If you have symptoms of COVID-19 YOU MUST NOT ENTER THE BUILDING.
- If you develop symptoms within the next seven days please inform us by contacting the vicarage on 01937 520951.
- Please use the hand sanitiser as you enter church.
- If you did not pre-book through the office please ensure you fill in a card with your contact details (using your own pen) and place it in the box as you leave church. This is purely to enable us to trace people if a case of COVID-19 is reported to us.
- Follow the instructions of the Sides person(s) at all times.
- There is a 'one-way' system around church, please follow the arrows and stick within the walkways.
- Please adhere to the 2 metres social distancing guidance.
- To keep passing people to a minimum please fill pews from the front.
- DO NOT go into a blocked off pew or sit in a seat marked closed.
- Please take your seat immediately and stay in your seat unless ushered by the Sides Person. DO NOT stand at the back or wander around church to 'socialise'.
- Once seated DO NOT turn around or lean across to talk to others.
- To maximise seating, singular worshippers are asked to use the side pews and multiple member households to use the middle pews.
- Young children should be supervised and remain with their parent or guardian at all times. The Children's corner is out of use.
- To avoid queues worshippers will be ushered forward for Communion one pew at a time. Please follow the instructions of the Sides person.
- Communicants to stand at the altar rail at the signed administration point, one at a time, ensuring social distancing is maintained.
- We ask that you hand sanitise before receiving the bread.
- Please exit church via the South Porch door following the direction arrows. To avoid queues and people passing each other worshippers will be asked to exit church one pew at a time. Please follow the instructions of the Sides person.
- Please use the hand sanitiser as you leave church.
