Last week's message, from the parable of the sower in Matthew 13, showed us a whole life approach to scattering kingdom seeds. Rather than one seed at one time, our lifestyle, which is an outworking of our faith in Christ, will automatically scatter kingdom seed wherever we are.

This week, as we revisit the parable we reflect on the hands-off approach to growing the crops from which our seed is sown.

In modern gardening and farming there's all sorts of treatments we can use to help crops grow; chemical supplements such as fertilizer, pesticide, PH treatments etc. In the 1st century, however, the growth of a crop was a little more nature dependent and, as our parable points out, soil dependent.

With all good motives, many Christians are desperate for people they know and meet to respond to the gospel. They're so desperate that they will give time and attention to persuade, cajole or just persistently badger someone in the hope they will commit their life to following Jesus.

As we'll reflect on today, however, there is something of a 'let go and let God' approach which is evident in Scripture and which we can learn from ourselves.


