

Building Update: The architects are preparing more detailed drawings of plans for the Church redevelopment. The surveyor is preparing a reviewed cost budget which we hope will be more in line with our budget. The committee is preparing to submit new proposals for a car park. At the APCM on Thursday 30th May at 7.30pm the Building Group will give an illustrated update on the rebuilding proposals. You will be able to ask any questions.
