

South Lakes

My elderly father has received huge bills from his energy supplier which are completely wrong. We have tried to phone the company, but they never take any notice and they have now sent a letter saying they are sending his details to a debt collection agency. He is worried sick. What can we do?

Contact your local Citizens Advice immediately to get help with this. Your father is not alone – Citizens Advice nationally has seen a rise in poor practice from energy companies over the past year. In your father’s case, this is clearly a mistake, but Citizens Advice is helping increasing numbers of people who are in energy debt. We have seen a surge in harmful debt collection practices, with some suppliers not offering affordable debt repayment plans, using Debt Collection Agencies while consumers are still trying to agree a repayment plan, and taking people to court to recover the money, which causes distress and significantly increases the debt. Court enforcement may increase now that Ofgem has introduced tougher rules on force fitting of prepayment meters. Some providers do support their customers well, but Citizens Advice is asking Ofgem to protect the most vulnerable consumers, by enforcing the provision of affordable repayment plans, issuing guidance on the use of Debt Collection Agencies, and limiting court action and enforcement where this puts people at risk of harm.



St. Peter's Churchyard

Good progress has been made by the Working Party in St Peter's churchyard over recent weeks. In addition to our usual tasks of cutting ivy, elder and other such plants we have had a couple of quite large fallen branches to remove and we appreciated assistance from our neighbour Alan in helping with an awkward one.

When a large yew had to be felled for safety reasons a few years ago the branches and brash were left against the boundary wall at the east of the churchyard. It was left there at the time as it was clear that it would be a major task to remove it all and, of course, the size of the task increased over the years as grass, nettles and other plants grew through the branches. At our last meeting we managed to drag most of the branches out, cut them up and burn them. The remaining waste was dealt with the following week. That end of the churchyard is in much better shape now.

The Churchyard Working Party won't meet in July or August but a September meeting is expected, date to be confirmed closer to the time. Anybody who would like to contribute to the upkeep of the churchyard is very welcome to join us. We meet on irregular Saturday mornings from 9.30am – 12.00 noon, dates are published as widely as we can on social media, news-sheets and the next-door app. There is no need to feel that you have to attend on time and stay to the end, we all do what we can and it is fine to arrive when it is convenient and to leave when you have to.

Dear Friends,



One hundred years ago, Paris hosted the Olympic Games, as it does this year. The events of the 1924 Games may be familiar to us from the Oscar-winning film 'Chariots of Fire'. One of the athletes featured was Scotsman Eric Liddell. While at the University of Edinburgh, Eric became famous for being the fastest runner in Scotland. By 1924, Liddell was seen as the natural choice to run the 100 metres, 200 metres and relays for Great Britain. However, he had chosen to withdraw as these events included Sunday heats. Liddell's Christian convictions didn't allow him to run on a Sunday.

One option remained, the 400 metres. Unlike today, in 1924 nobody sprinted the whole race. Eric changed all this. Liddell ran the first 200 metres as hard as he could, stunning the spectators. And then he ran the next 200 metres harder. He passed the tape four metres ahead of his nearest competitor. His finishing time of 47.6 seconds was an Olympic and World Record.

In the film, Liddell explains his motivation for running: God "made me fast, and when I run, I feel his pleasure."

Liddell loved to run but it wasn't his entire life. He knew that, win or lose, ultimately his worth wasn't dependent on his performance on the track. He believed his sporting ability was a gift from God that brought him great joy, rather than something that defined his life. While he is famous today as an athlete, the greater part of his adult life was spent as a missionary. He went to China in 1925 and served as a teacher until 1943. He was also ordained as a Congregational minister in 1932.

In 1943 Liddell was interned by the Japanese forces. He became a leader and organiser at the POW camp, helping the elderly, taking Bible classes at the camp school, arranging games, and teaching science to the children, who referred to him as 'Uncle Eric'.

Sadly, Eric had an inoperable brain tumour, and overwork and malnutrition may have hastened his death. He died on 21 February 1945, five months before liberation. Eric was buried in the garden behind the Japanese officers' quarters; his grave marked by a small wooden cross. The site was forgotten until it was rediscovered in 1989

In 1991, the University of Edinburgh erected a memorial headstone at the former camp site in Weifang. The simple inscription came from Isaiah Ch 40 verse 31 – *"They shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run and not be weary."*
