

South Lakes

**We're booking a summer holiday to Spain.
What can we do to prepare and protect
ourselves from things going wrong?**

The first thing to do is check if your passport is in date. Renewing can take several weeks. This is especially important if you're flying to Europe as EU countries no longer accept passports that are more than ten years old, even if the expiry date is more than ten years from the issue date.

If your flight is delayed for a long time, your airline has to give you access to food and drink vouchers, phone calls and emails, and accommodation if you're delayed overnight. If your flight is cancelled, you have a legal right to a full refund or replacement flight to help you get to your destination. You also have a right to claim compensation if your airline delays, loses or damages your checked-in luggage.

Compensation for other things, like a day trip being cancelled, or not being given the standard of room you paid for, depends on whether you booked a package holiday or arranged it independently, so you need to check the details.

Get travel insurance as soon as you book a holiday. You may have an existing insurance policy. Insurance can cover many of the things already mentioned, but also events like medical emergencies. If you need advice, check the Citizens Advice website, or contact South Lakes Citizens Advice.



St Peter's Church Ashes Area



There has been exciting progress in improving the area where Ashes are interred in the St Peter's churchyard. After much discussion and consultation the PCC was delighted to go ahead with the proposal as shown on the plan, in the confidence that it was well supported and would enhance an important area of the churchyard. Phase 1, the placing of engraved kerbs and paving, is almost complete and has been well received. It really does indicate the importance of that area of the churchyard to so many people.

The benefits of Phase 1 are that;

- attractive stone kerbs delimit the area and indicate that it is a special area of ground
- each ashes plot can be identified through numbers and letters inscribed on the kerbstones

There has been a pause in progress however as the builder carrying out the work has been in an accident that resulted in injuries which mean that he will be off sick for a while. We wish him well and look forward to his return to work.

Phase 2 of the project makes sense of the whole scheme. It is a slate memorial plaque to be mounted on a stand next to the interment area. The plaque will show a grid that might be imagined on the ground and which will be inscribed with the names of those whose ashes are interred in each square (plot), thus it will be possible to identify where particular ashes are located. Future interments will also be recorded on the slate memorial. An actual size print-out of the grid with existing names can be seen in church. The church is open during the day.

The improvement work is estimated to cost a fraction under £18,000.

Costs so far have been met from PCC funds and from generous donations for which the PCC is most grateful. Nevertheless further donations are necessary for the project to be completed and about another £10,000 is still required.

Dear Friends,

In recent weeks it been suggested that a Christian should not hold public office within the United Kingdom, due to the nature of their beliefs. This silencing of certain views has been

characterised as being part of a 'cancel culture'. The wider issues of freedom of speech and what is acceptable in public discourse are hot topics within society today.

There are several ways you can react to speech that you do not agree with. Firstly, you can listen and disagree and argue back. You can seek to persuade the other person to a better, clearer understanding of the truth.

Secondly, you can simply ignore what people are saying, you can turn off your television or stop reading or listening.

The third alternative is to stop the person from speaking, if you don't like what they are saying. Shoot the messenger, cancel their opportunity, de-platform them, so they cannot say anything. It is saying to a speaker, "What you are saying must not be said or expressed by anyone at any time. And if we ever find out that you have expressed them, we will punish you."

This option puts terrific pressure on people to watch their words; effectively certain opinions are silenced through self-censorship. Ultimately this option is sinister. Here is real bigotry and intolerance.

And yet this clamour for cancellation recognises something important from the very first page of the Bible, about the nature of speech itself. Christians believe in the power and truth of speech, because God speaks with power and truth. God created speech. He's the first speaker – he spoke, and the world came into existence. He created the world by speech. As the psalmist says, "By the word of the Lord the heavens were made."

Words have power and words have truth. Elected politicians do not usually go out to build roads, but by their words they have the power to get other people to build roads. The words of leaders are powerful words.

But God is all powerful, his words create the universe. Not only is power conveyed in words, but also truth. It is possible to express truth through speech, because that is how God has brought reality into being. Human beings are made in the image of God, and he creates us in his image as speakers.

That does not mean that Christians always get in right in what we say, but that we believe that truth is knowable, because ultimately truth comes to us as a person, a fellow human - Jesus, who said, I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. Nor have Christians always expressed what they believe in kind words. We are called to speak the truth in love.

But when we get it wrong, we get corrected by the truth. We should always be open to reasoned argument, and assume that we're capable of being wrong. However, when we are silenced, that opportunity for reasoned discussion is taken from us. There must be freedom to speak, because truth comes through words.

However Christian speech should not be partitioned into the private sphere. God's speech is the foundation of the whole universe, not just the 'religious' part. Christians are to be authentically Christian wherever they are. Christians are citizens and taxpayers. They have as much right to speak in the public square as any other citizen or taxpayer. Like Saint Paul, Christians are to commend ourselves to everyone's conscience by the plain and open statement of the truth, and entrust ourselves to God (2 Corinthians chapter 4 verse 2).
