The Wedding Process at St. Mary's

Step 1: Booking the Wedding

If you fulfil the necessary legal requirements, we will be able to provisionally book your wedding. The Wedding Clerk will then arrange to meet with you to complete the paperwork and finalise your booking. Please note the time of your wedding cannot change within 3 months of the date agreed.

Step 2: More Information (9-12 months before the big day!)

We will get in touch and invite you to a wedding preparation session to give your more information which you can take away to think about.

Step 3: Planning the Ceremony (3-6 months before the big day!)

As your wedding gets nearer, we will be in touch to help plan the ceremony itself. You will need to decide on hymns, music and readings. We will talk through the wedding service together, exploring what the vows and promises mean and why they are so important.

Following this meeting the invoice will be prepared. Payment is due 6 weeks before the wedding.

Step 4: The Rehearsal (The day before the wedding)

This happens at noon on the day before the ceremony. We walk and talk through the whole service.

Step 5: The big day has arrived!

There is nothing more to worry about, just enjoy it!
