Coronavirus Update

With the "unlock" progressing and the vaccine roll out continuing, the PCCs in the Benefice have decided to move back to holding services in church buildings from the start of May. Details of where and when services will be held are set out below. Do come and worship in person!

- Face coverings - Must be worn for all church services and are available when you attend
- Hand Sanitiser - Available and must be used as we enter church and before we take communion
- Singing - We cannot currently sing in church as a congregation
