

Our Neighbourhood

The L23 postcode includes Crosby village, where there is a Sainsbury's and a Home Bargains store, College Road, where you will find a Post Office, Chemist, Co-op and petrol station, Coronation Road for Tesco Express, as well as an Aldi store in Thornton. There are many restaurants and cafes to meet with friends, and some good take-aways to enjoy as well.



If you like sports, Waterloo Rugby Club, the Champion Lawn Tennis Club and the renowned West Lancashire Golf Club are within a five-minute walk of our church. Marine Athletic Football Club is also nearby, on College Road. Crosby Leisure Centre has a 25-metre swimming pool, state-of-the-art gym and sports hall, and is located by Crosby Beach, made famous by Anthony Gormley's Iron Men statues, titled "Another Place".



These individual figures, gazing reflectively out across the Mersey estuary, create a liminal space where at least one member of our congregation has found faith. The sunsets are often magnificent, the coffee and ice cream vans are also magnificent, and it is a wonderful place to look for sea glass, walk the dog, take the family, and also access the Sefton Coastal Path, which meanders for 21 miles between Crosby and Southport. Cyclists and runners enjoy this route, which can take you up to Hightown and to the National Trust operated Formby Beach and Formby Pinewoods.

If you love nature, you should know that we have a few red squirrels in our neighbourhood too! We have a few parks, such as Coronation Park, Alexandra Park, The Duck Pond (which seems to be full of turtles, at the moment!), Victoria Park, and Little Crosby Pathway.
