

The Nave Stained Glass Windows

The Great West Window 'Transfiguration of Christ' (c1882)

This is a memorial window dedicated to the Revd Fitz Wygram bearing the inscription:

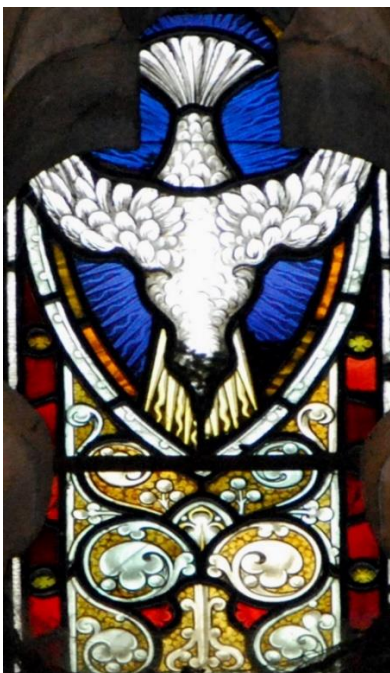
"To the Glory of God and in loving remembrance of Fitzroy John Fitzwygram, first vicar of this parish 1863-1881

"This window is erected by his parishioners and friends

*"A faithful man and feared God'
He entered into rest August 13th 1881"*

It is at the west end of the church, above the porch, the original of which was also built in Revd Fitz Wygram's memory.

£500 was collected by public subscription for these memorials.



High above the nave at the entrance to the chancel is a tiny window depicting the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove
