**Dear all the Council have sent out the following,**

**The council has received reports of people posing as parking Civil Enforcement Officers (CEOs) in the borough and cloning bank cards by asking motorists to pay an on-the-spot fine using a card reader. Council Enforcement Officers will never ask for payment in person using a card machine or by cash Also:**

**Residents are reminded that the council's CEO's (traffic wardens) wear a green uniform with Hillingdon and APCOA logos and ID numbers displayed on their shoulders. (Please see photo below. \*Note that APCOA environmental enforcement officers – EET's, wear black uniforms.)**

**In June, another scam involving a fake QR code on a TfL PayByPhone parking meter at Ickenham station car park was also reported.**

**The council does not use QR codes for payment at its car parks and residents are encouraged to download the PayByPhone app to their mobile.**

**The police are investigating all incidents and urge anyone who has been a victim of these scams to report it.**
