

In addition to updating dates for the current round of Stationing for 2012, hypertext links, and other minor nuances, the following changes have been made to the Code of Practice:

- A11 Additional sentence at the end from the Ministries Committee Manses Group with hyperlink.
- Section B and K6 Diaconal profile forms returned at the **same time as presbyteral forms**
- C7** Major addition concerning Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI). In particular **Circuit Invitation Committees to engage with the EDI Toolkit Module on ‘Unconscious Bias’** – hypertext link included.
- E11 & J11 Circuit Invitation Committee resolution to the Circuit Meeting: if a member of the Circuit Meeting wishes to oppose the recommendation or move an amendment the written notice should be **signed** by the person or persons opposing the recommendation.
- E23 When the extension being considered is that of a Pioneer minister, advice sought from the connexional **Evangelism and Growth Team**.
- F10 Presbyters may identify five possible matches **and may include up to five ‘critical’ appointments**.
- F18, G2, L2 Additional reference to EDI
I5, N5
I15, N15
- G1 & L1 Where a Circuit submits more than one profile in any given year, the title of the profiles must be clear (not just a number)
- I8 & N8 Need for Circuit to make provision for accompanying family or friends when the minister has role specific conversations such as with members of the Circuit Invitation Committee
- Letters of Understanding - updating of information re. supervision with hypertext link and MDR reference.
- Appendix 6 Critical Appointment pro forma rather than just a statement of criteria
- Appendix 7 Three flowcharts to help Circuit Stewards navigate the process. As with the ‘Summary’ document, these are provided as an aid and not intended to replace reading the Code of Practice!
- Appendix 8 To inform any future Stationing Matching Group meeting, a pro forma for use where a match has been declined
