What is the Young Leaders Scheme?

The Young Leaders Scheme is a programme that provides the opportunity for 16-23 years to be employed by their Methodist Church or Circuit.

This could involve doing youth work, children's work, running a café, supporting the elderly, developing social media or getting involved with a gardening project.

The Scheme is extremely flexible on what your project could involve. It would be a conversation and decision made by the Young Leader, the Young Leaders Scheme Coordinator and your church or circuit.

How to recruit

In terms of recruiting a young person for the scheme, there are two approaches that can be taken.

If you have a project that you would like a young leader to be involved with then you can advertise for a young leader.

Alternatively, you may have a specific person in mind for the scheme, and so the project can be set up around that person.
