(Numbers refer to sections overleaf)

At least seven (7) days notice is required before the first reading of banns.

(3) If either of you will not be 18 by the proposed date of the wedding, the priest will need to know whether the consent of parents has been obtained.

(6) Make sure you include the name of the town, county, and Postcode.

(15) This means the Church of England parish where you *live*. If either of you lives in a different parish from that in which the marriage is to take place, you have to arrange for the banns to be read there too and to obtain a banns certificate. (There is a cost for this which changes year by year)
