Defeated by eternal life.*

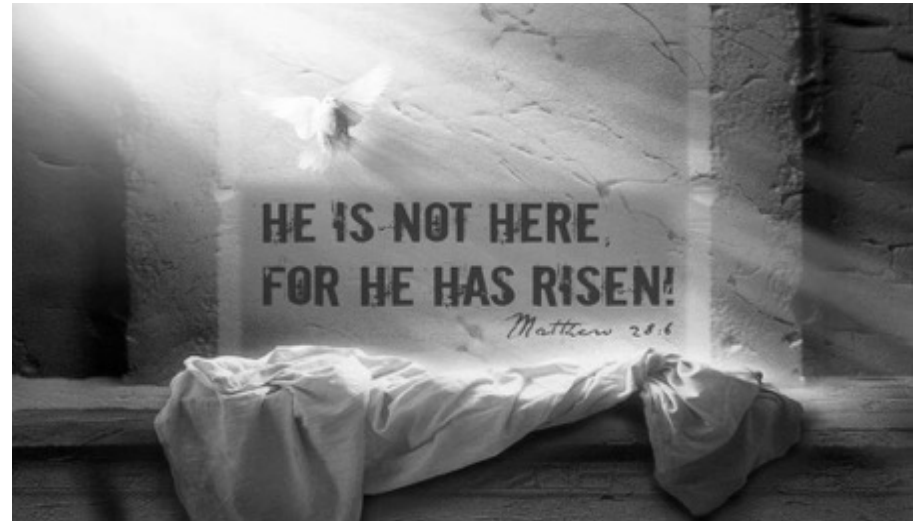
