Collect of the day

Eternal Father, whose Son Jesus Christ ascended to the throne of heaven that he might rule over all things as Lord and King; keep the Church in the unity of the Spirit and in the bond of peace, and bring the whole created order to worship at his feet; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.



Today is the final Sunday of the Liturgical year and is the first feast day that focuses on the authority of Christ. It is also called Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

It is a festival celebrated in honour of Jesus Christ as Lord over all creation. Essentially a magnification of the Feast of the Ascension

When we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we declare to the world and remind ourselves that Jesus is the Lord, not only of the Church, but of the universe

Many people celebrate Jesus Christ with a celebration that can feature food items such as crown cupcakes (a representation of Christ as king); cakes topped with icing thorns or King Cakes baked in the shape of a crown.

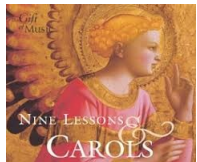
