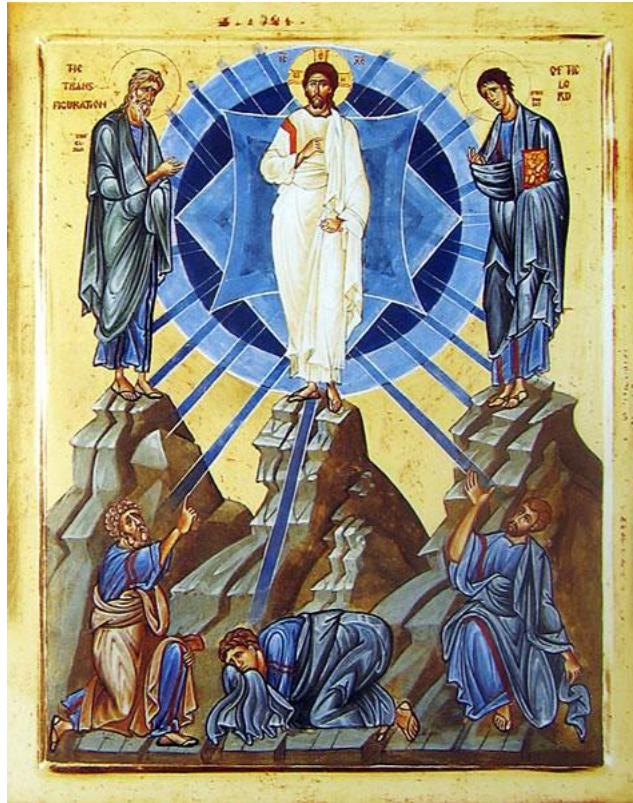

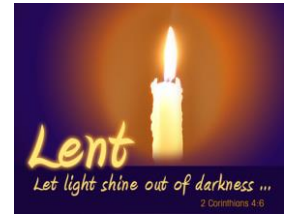

PCC Foundation Governors: Jeanette and Tiny were reappointed.

APCM: PCC agreed APCM would be held after the service on Sunday 23 May 2021.

Updates:

Repairs to the doors: Our west doors are being restored and our porch doors are being replaced thanks to two grants from the National Lottery Fund.

Spires Business Plan: PCC thanked Spires for their work on our behalf and is now considering the proposals.

Finance:

Hall Use income: Discussed raising our hall hire fees. Mther Bernadette & Boikanyo to develop a Hall Use Policy.
