Just to alert you that from September 2016, Stepney Area Centre for Training and Development will be offering a new range of Lay Adult Education and Learning modules on a variety of subjects, including the Bible, Mission, Ministry and Church.

The modules will be in 'bite-size' chunks of 5/6 weeks each. More details will be available shortly.

Brand new Diocesan Christian Studies Course for lay people, being run at the St Edmund Centre in the City.
