PCC highlights:

Safeguarding: We have caught up with our Safeguarding tasks and most people have now had their DBS checks confirmed.

Transformations Group: We have set up a Transformation Group to co-ordinate the second stage of our repairs where we will be exploring options re: wiring, lighting and heating. Members of the group are Safia, Julian, Mthr. Bernadette and Ruth (who has kindly agreed to lead).

Car Parking: Zip Cars will be renting three car parking spaces on a one year contract from August and will bring in much needed income.

St Paul with St Luke's School: This has been an incredible year for our church school. Earlier this year they got 'GOOD' in both the SIAMS inspection and the Ofsted Inspection. Now we have just heard that Year 6 have done amazingly well in their SATs and the school has won an award for healthy eating.

Little Lights: Our mums and toddlers play group which runs Fridays from 1.30-3pm in our church hall will take a well-earned break during the summer holidays and will re-open in the new term.
