Revision of the Electoral Roll ends today.

The new Electoral Roll will be published on **Saturday 31 March 2018**.

Nominations forms for the election of **2 church wardens, 3 members of the PCC** are out today. On the three-yearly cycle, Iyabode, Ayo and Sally stand down (they may be proposed again for another three years).

Deanery Synod Reps, like PCC members are elected for a three-year period and are ex officio members of the PCC.

If you haven't served on the PCC before, now is the time to give it due prayer and consideration.

Please note: Only members of the Electoral Roll can stand for PCC or propose another.



A letter has been received by a number of Muslim organisations in the north of England stating that 3 April is national Punish A Muslim Day and Muslims should expect to be attacked on that day.

No letters have been received in Tower Hamlets, but the contents have been shared very widely and we are aware of a great deal of fear and insecurity amongst our Muslim neighbours here. As a result United East End, the East London Mosque, THIFF,

etc, etc, have decided that because of the fear within the local community we cannot just ignore these stupid letters.

Therefore we are advertising **3 April as National Happier Together Day** and are asking everyone to participate in a variety of positive, affirming ways, which can be begun now.
