## **The Annual Meeting – today after the service**

Our Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) takes place **today**. The Parish Church Council (PCC) will give an account of their past year's work and stewardship of the church during which 2 Churchwardens & 3 PCC members.

The PCC exists to support the minister in the mission and ministry of the church. So being on the PCC is about sharing in the leadership of the church. It is both a responsibility and a privilege to serve in this way.
