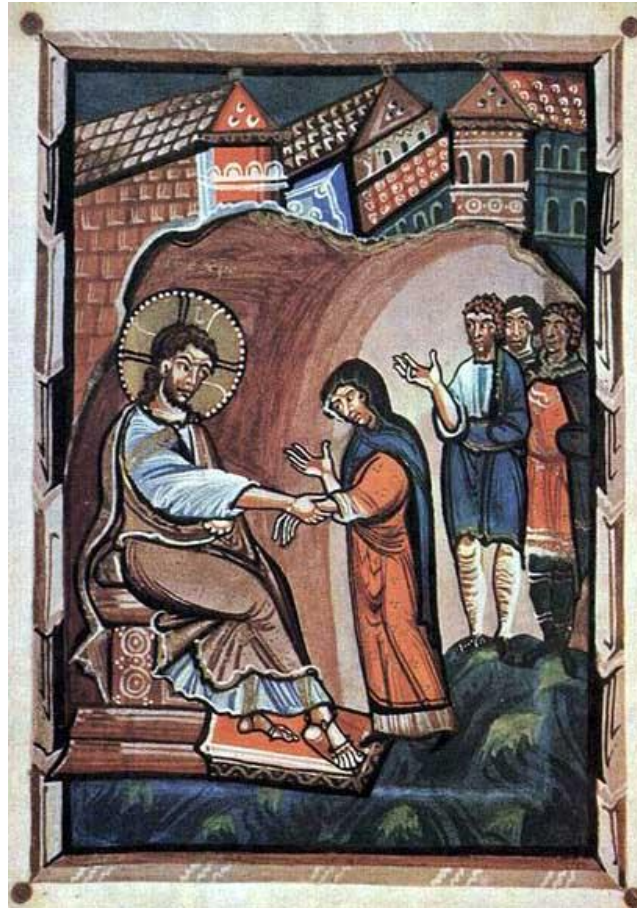

PCC Highlights

Safeguarding: PCC agreed Elaine Cuthbert, Lynette Smith and Safia Dimsdale to be Safeguarding Officers. Important for Safeguarding Officers to attend church regularly. PCC reviewed and adopted Safeguarding Policy Statement and Safeguarding Guidelines. Annual Safeguarding self-audit reviewed and agreed in the meeting.

Projects: regarding building and near neighbours project on hold while Mthr. Bernadette is on jury service.

Open Church: church has been open for nearly 4 months with no incidents and many inspiring comments in the visitor's book

GDPR: Policy for role holders and non-role holders have been circulated. Permission not required for electoral roll and APCM invitations. Written consent forms being collected and held in sacristy.

Common Fund: Our contribution was discussed, and it was agreed to increase it by £1,000. £31,000 will be proposed to Deanery Finance meeting as our 2019 contribution.

Updates: PCC expressed their appreciation of the Sunday School performance on Pentecost Sunday.

Little Lights: suggestion to ask at the school and among mums for help on Fridays thinking ahead to Laurie's maternity.

Any other Business: Laurie offered her resignation from PCC due to personal and health reasons. PCC recorded thanks for Laurie's contribution and service
