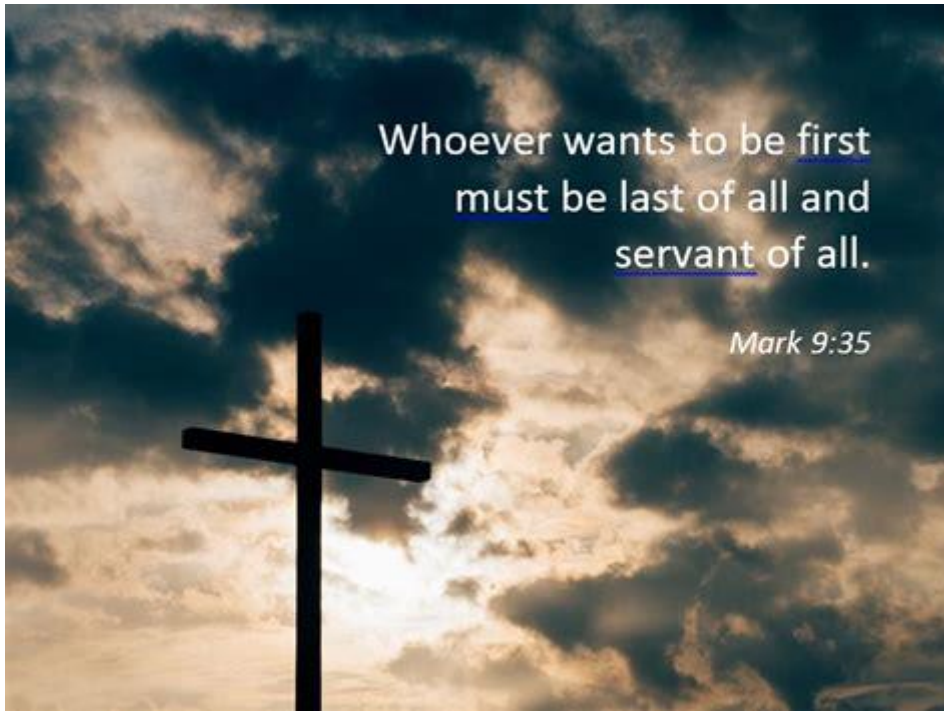

As the winning team, we are hosting the event this time.

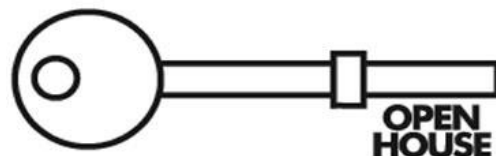
