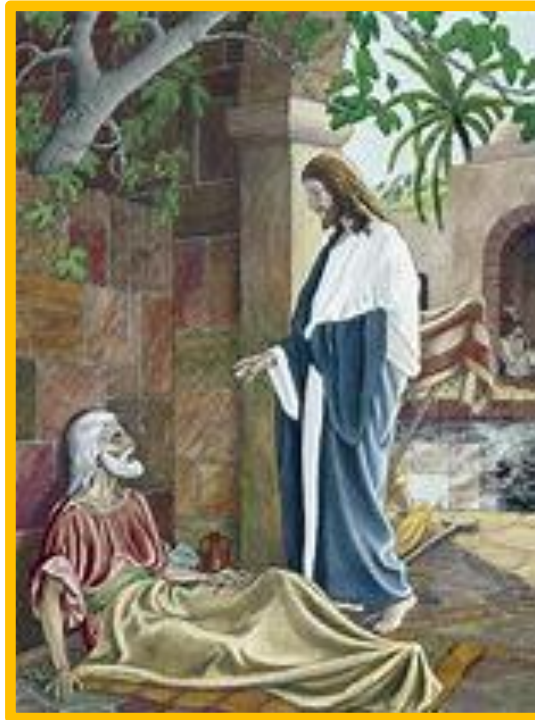

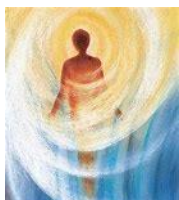

## A Call to Prayer: Thy Kingdom Come



Thy Kingdom Come is a global prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray for more people to come to know Jesus. What started in 2016 as an invitation from the Archbishops of Canterbury and York to the Church of England has grown into an international ecumenical call to prayer.

**During the 11 days of Thy Kingdom Come (30<sup>th</sup> May to 9<sup>th</sup> June 2019)** it is hoped that everyone who takes part will:

Deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ

Pray for God's spirit to work in the lives of those they know

Come to realise that every aspect of their life is the stuff of prayer.

**A prayer resource – Pray for 5 friends.** Praying for others to know Jesus is one of the most powerful things we can do. Persistent prayer for others brings transformation to their lives. Choose 5 people you would like to pray for between **Ascension and Pentecost (30<sup>th</sup> May to 9<sup>th</sup> June)** and write their names down onto a list. If you're not sure who to pray for, ask God to guide you as you choose. Once you have settled on 5 names, commit to praying for them regularly by praying the following:

*Thank you Father that no-one is beyond your reach.*

*You bring peace to those who are far away and to those who are near.*

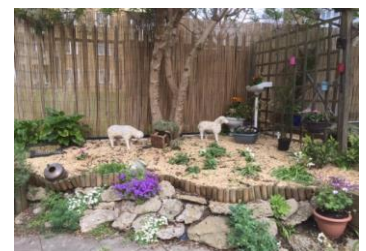
*Reveal yourself to (names)*
