**Sunday School** are also taking a well deserved break in August starting up again on **Sunday 22 September.** Children are very welcome to make use of the Children's Corner next to the

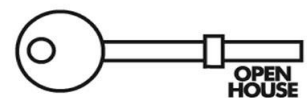
Lady Chapel during services.
