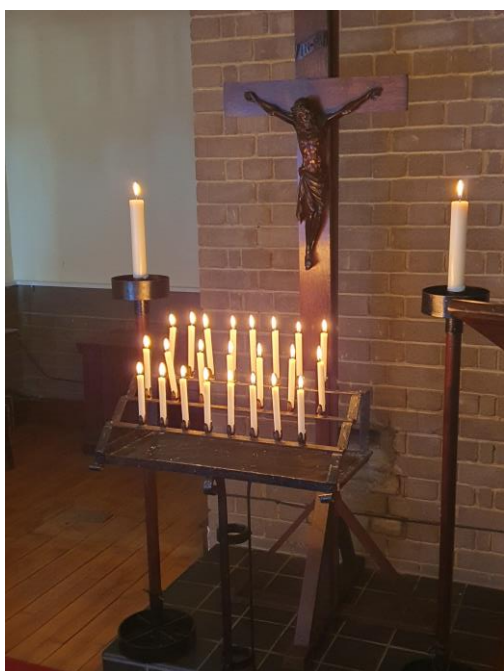
I wish you all a Joyful Easter! May the peace of the Risen Christ be with you this day and always.
