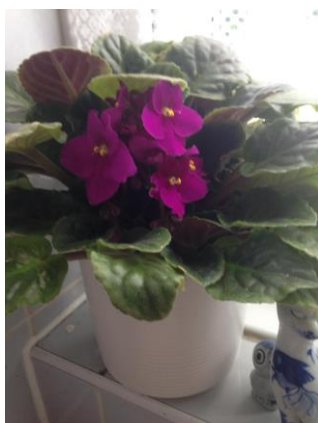
Today we celebrate the **6th Sunday of Easter**. Our journey through Easter Time continues until Pentecost.

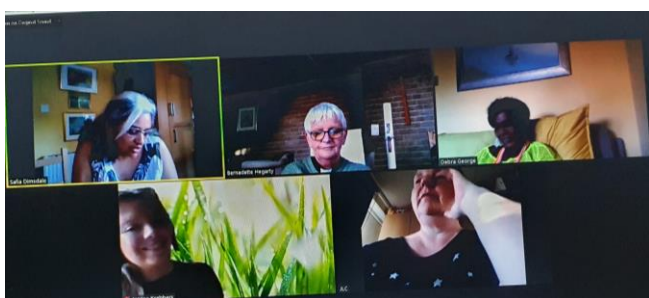
Lockdown Birthdays:
