Today we celebrate **first Sunday after Trinity** – as we begin our journey through ordinary time until we reach the season of Remembrance. But do stay alert, God often does the extraordinary in the ordinary!

Refreshing the Prayer List: Every so often we revise the list of people for whom we pray regularly, and which appears on this sheet and on the website. We try to keep this current and meaningful by ‘refreshing’ the list and starting again.

Today the 14th June is the third anniversary of the Grenfell Tower fire. The idea this year (in the midst of the pandemic) is that **at 6pm bells in churches all across London would ring 72 times. This would initiate two minutes silence,** after which **there would be three more rings, one for each year since the fire itself.**



In this way, in the absence of public events, people across London might be reminded of the anniversary and those who still live with the memory of the fire would feel that this important moment for them is marked in a properly public way. An online vigil will begin at that point for those who wish to access it.

So I will be ringing the bell of our church later today to mark this occasion. I will Zoom the service and you are welcome to join me on Zoom.

Parking Barrier Appeal – Your support is needed. As many of you know, people park in our carpark without permission. The PCC have agreed that the solution is an electronic barrier across the St Paul's Way entrance. This will enable us to control who parks there and it will also ensure that those who do support the church financially with donations will be able to park.



The barrier doesn't come cheap – our quote 12 months ago was **£8,000 approximately.**

We now have planning permission to go ahead. However since the pandemic we have seen our income greatly reduced so it would be great if we could raise £1,000 ourselves therefore all **fundraising ideas and donations** welcome.
