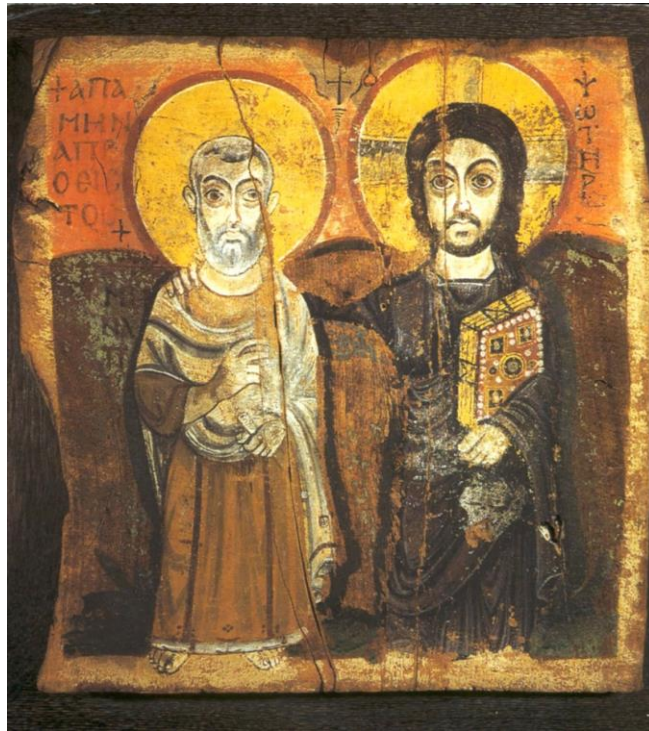

Today we celebrate the **fourth Sunday after Trinity** and as we journey through this season of Ordinary Time let us be aware that God is at work in the ordinary times of our lives as well as in the special times!

Today we give thanks for the NHS which celebrates its **72nd birthday**. And on Tuesday we remember in our prayers all who were killed and those who survived the **7/7 bombings of 2005** and their families.



The Government allowed faith buildings to open for worship from 4th July. We will be discussing when and how we open for Sunday worship at our **PCC meeting on Wednesday 8th July**.

In the meantime, the church will start to be open for **Morning and Evening Prayer at 8.30am & 5.30pm during the week from Monday 6th July**. Mthr. Bernadette will continue to Zoom these services from church, but you are welcome to join her in church whilst maintaining the appropriate social distance if you wish.

If you have any thoughts about when we open for Sunday worship, do let Mthr. Bernadette or another member of the PCC know. It's important that we return to gathering in church when it is safe for everyone to do so.

May PCC Meeting Highlights:

APCM: date set for **Sunday 27th September** after the service. PCC approved Annual Report.

Common Fund: Diocese have agreed a reduction in current year's contribution due to loss of income from pandemic. Offer for next year will be agreed in the autumn.

Finance: a significant loss of income from hall hire and from parking.

Return to church building: clergy now allowed back in church to stream services. It is envisaged that returning to the building will be gradual and in stages, but still some time away. When return does happen physical distancing measures will need to be observed as well as a strict cleaning regime. The PCC acknowledged that it will feel a little stange, but expressed a real desire to see people in church again.
