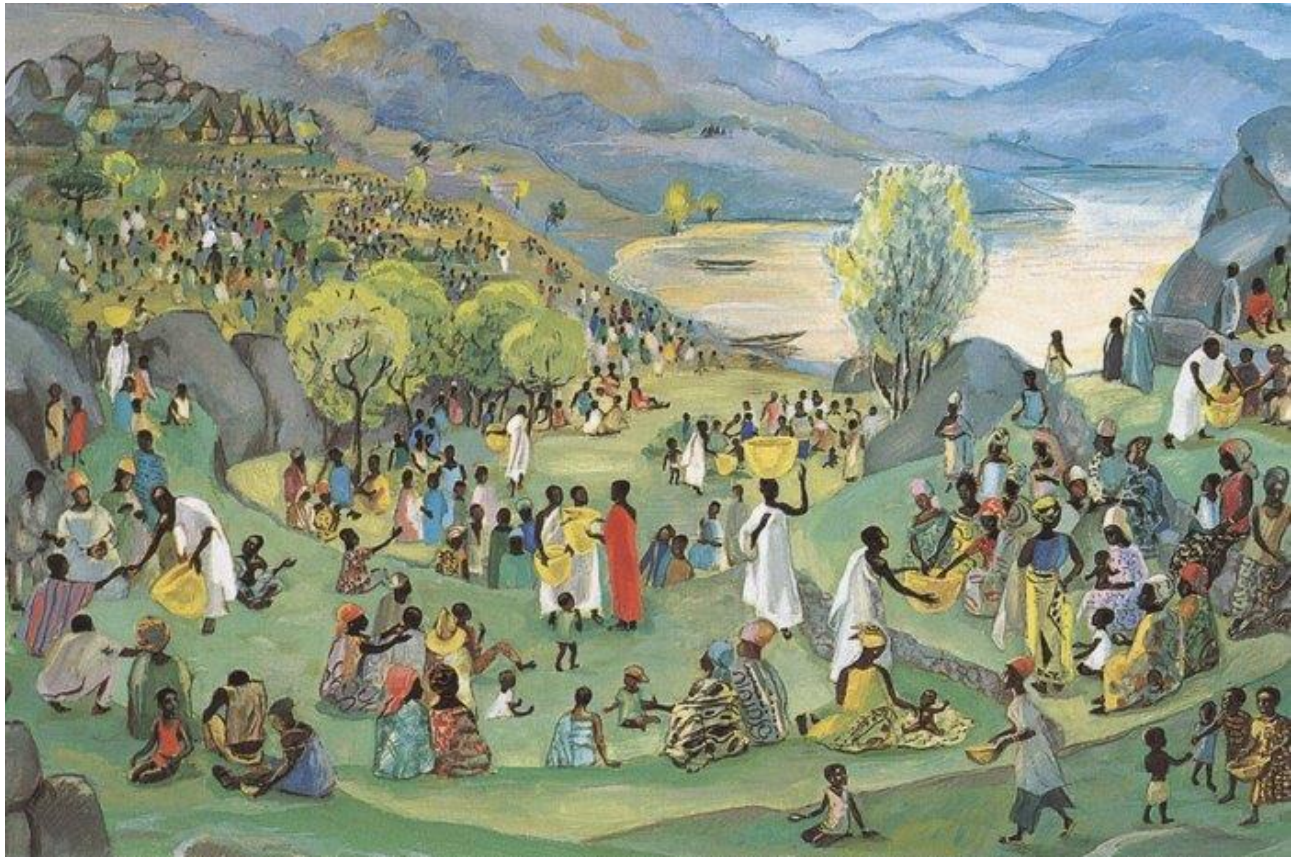

Returning to worship in our church: Sunday 6 September at 10am.

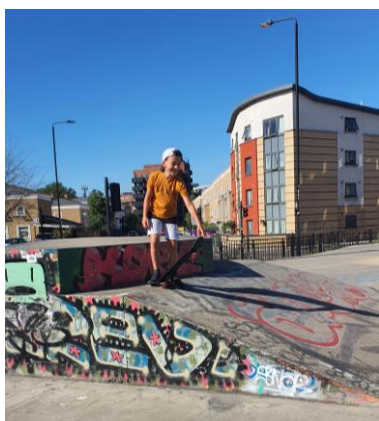
