- We will also need to keep a register of who attends with contact details to comply with 'track & trace'.
- Sadly there will be no singing or hymns, but there will be recorded music.
- The Order of Service will be uploaded via Whatsapp for you to follow. There will be a few paper copies printed out midweek for anyone who does not have a mobile/tablet.
- Sadly there will be no refreshments.
- Once you are in your seat, you will need to remain there until a Welcomer shows you out.
- Offertory Collection – place your donation/envelope in the Offertory Plate upon entry.
- Do offer the peace with bow or a way but remain at your seat.
- There will not be an opportunity to light a votive candle.
- Initially there will be no Sunday School.

## **Keeping ourselves & each other safe**

- Remember to bring your mask and wear it during the service.
- Please have the Order of Service ready on your phone/tablet.
- Upon entry – please sanitize your hands.
- Keep your distance at all times.
- You will be guided to your seat by a Welcomer.
- At the peace, we offer the peace from our places.
- Remain standing at your place to receive Holy Communion – Mthr Bernadette will come to you. When consuming the sacrament, be careful to take off and put your mask back on safely
- If you really need to access the toilets during the service, please use the Sanitizing Station before and afterwards.
