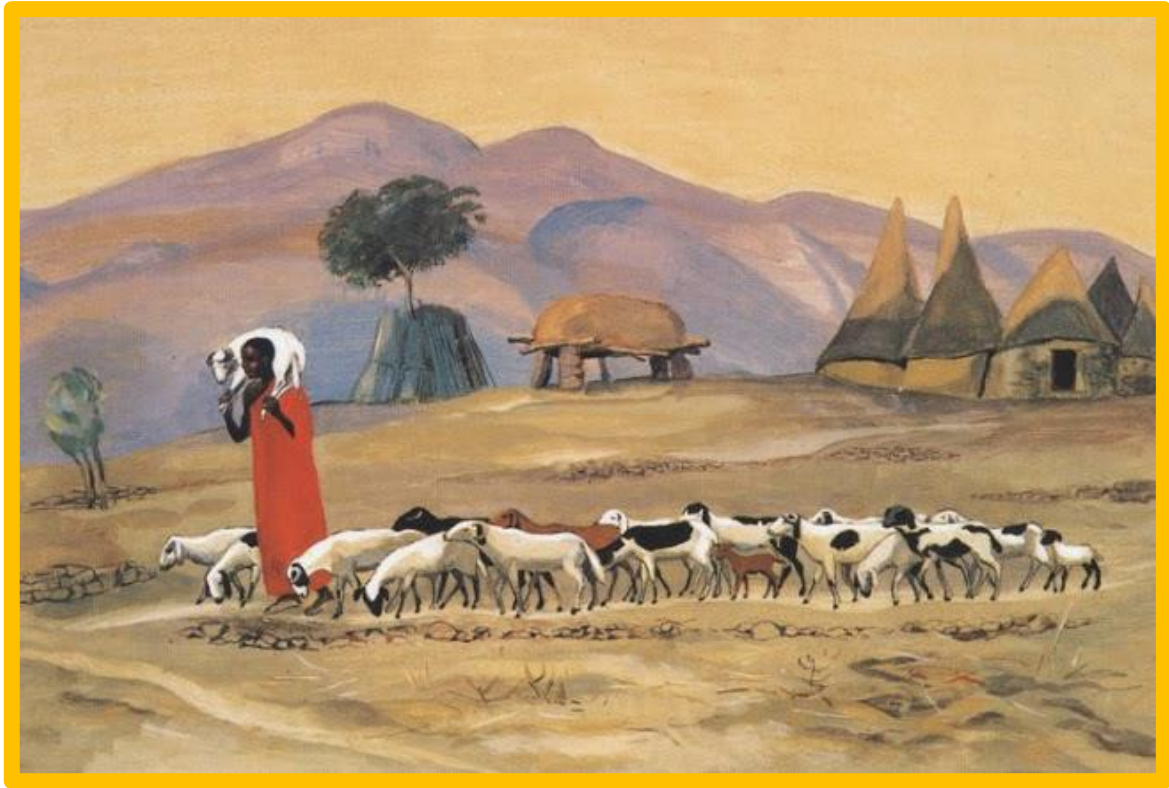

Today we celebrate the **4th Sunday of Easter**. Having journeyed through the 6 weeks of Lent and Holy Week, experienced the sorrow of Good Friday and the joy of Easter Day, we are now well into the season of Eastertide which continues until Pentecost.

Next Sunday we will celebrate **the Dedication of the Church**, by processing around the church in a covid safe way listening to **hymns 9, 76** (*we would normally sing*) as we light each candle. This will take place during the sermon slot, following a brief homily. As we go, anyone who lit the wall candles at the great 50th Anniversary celebrations will each light 'their' candle again. Not all of them will be there so you may be asked to light one on the behalf of someone, please do so at the appropriate time.

Being on St Paul's PCC

The PCC exists to support the minister in the mission and ministry of the church. So being on the PCC is about sharing in the leadership of the church. It is both a responsibility and a privilege to serve in this way.

2 Church Wardens are elected annually. Julian has faithfully been our sole Church Warden for the past two years and is willing to stand again. However, it would be great if this year we could be back at capacity and elect **2 church wardens.**

PCC members are elected every three years. In the three-year cycle, we have two people standing down (they may be proposed again for another three years) and we carried two vacancies from last year. So, we will be electing 4 PCC members.

Deanery Synod Reps, like PCC members are elected for a three-year period and are ex officio members of the PCC. Ruth was elected last year.

If you haven't served on the PCC before, now is the time to give it due prayer and consideration.

Please note that only members on the electoral roll of the church are able to nominate and vote in PCC and Deanery Synod elections. Parishioners and members on the electoral roll are entitled to nominate and vote for Church Wardens.
