SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY YEAR A 7th June 2020

Dear Parishioners,

'Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Through our life in Christ, we live the life of the Trinity. God is a perfect community and if we model our lives on the Trinity then the God of love and peace will be with us.' (Pope Saint John Sunday Missal.

Father Dominic writes: 'The Clergy of Saint Augustine's send you our greetings and hope that you continue to keep well and safe. We hope and pray that our children returning to School this Monday will settle happily and that our parents and staff will remain well and safe. We are very appreciative of the dedication of the Head teacher and Staff who have worked hard to prepare the School for the children's return. We also respect our parents who have decided not to send their children to School for the time being. As we look ahead to the re-opening of the Churches for private prayer, we realise that this will depend on enlisting volunteers to facilitate the re-opening. What I envisage is having 3 volunteers for each hour the Church is open, two to act as stewards and one for Church cleaning. Depending on the number of volunteers we enlist will determine the number of hours the Church will reopen. I envisage initially that the Church will be open on Saturday and Sunday between 12.00-2.00pm, We would therefore need 12 volunteers to cover these hours. Anyone who volunteers must be under 70 years of age and have no under lying health conditions. We therefore require young and healthy Parishioners to volunteer. Our priority must be your health and safety and therefore not having the Church open for anytime that we cannot adequately staff.'

Maryvale Sacred Heart Novena- all are invited to join on line for the Annual Novena to the Sacred Heart at the Shrine of the Sacred Heart at Maryvale Institute. There will be a Mass, Sermon and Novena live streamed each evening at 8pm from Thursday 11th June to Friday 19th June (Feast of the Sacred Heart).

Archbishop Bernard will be celebrating Mass on Sunday 21st June at 11am (on the day the 'physical' Pilgrimage would have taken place.) It will be live streamed from St Chad's Cathedral.
