READER: We pray for our community, our parish and all those gathered here today; that we might grow together in faith, love, and service to one another.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response Lord graciously hear us.

READER: We remember all who are sick, those in hospital and those who are housebound. Let us ask Mary the Mother of the Lord to pray with us: as we say- Hail Mary...Now let us pray for a few moments in silence for our own needs and intentions and for those intentions placed in the prayer box.

PRIEST: Heavenly Father, as we lift our prayers to you today, we do so with humble hearts and gratitude for your love, mercy and guidance. We ask for strength in times of weakness and peace in moments of doubt. Amen.
