We will therefore take small steps forward beginning with a 6.30pm Mass on a Friday evening, from Friday 2nd July. We will also return to the practise of receiving Holy Communion at the normal time, from Wednesday 30th June. Thank you to all our volunteers who have made such an important contribution in welcoming and caring for you whilst in Church.

Bishop David Evans has asked me to express his gratitude to all who contributed to the two recent Confirmation Masses, along with his visit to our primary school. Thank you to each and every one who helped to make it such a joyful day for those being Confirmed and for their sponsors and families. Bishop David has kindly agreed to return to the Parish to Confirm those who were unable to be Confirmed on his previous visit. He will be with us for Mass on Thursday 15th July at 9.30am. If you know of anyone who would wish to be Confirmed at this Mass please speak to one of the Clergy. On Tuesday 13th July we have our official Day of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. We would welcome your generous support for this day. A rota is available for you to sign in the front Porch, indicating when you may be available for a half-hour period to 'watch' before the Blessed Sacrament. The half-hour periods will begin at 10.30am and finish at 4pm.

We now have available on the Parish website the opportunity to request prayers for any person or intention. The intentions will then be placed in the Prayer Box in Church and will be prayed for during Mass.
