**Please remember** in your prayers our young Parishioners who are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> June. Bishop David Evans will be conferring the Sacrament.

**Our Covid working group** met to help plan the way forward with the easing of restrictions. We intend to re-introduce the Offertory Procession- those partaking will have the opportunity to sanitise their hands before bringing up the gifts. On Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June, we plan to re-introduce public morning Mass and hope that Parishioners would be happy to wipe their own seat. We hope to re-start the 12.30pm Mass on a Saturday before too long but we need more volunteers for this to be possible. We are following the new diocesan guidelines, which now also allow a change in seating arrangements, to have greater capacity. Stewards will guide you to a suitable seat. From June 21<sup>st</sup> we may be able to re-introduce Holy Communion at the normal time during Mass.
