

Solihull Churches Action on Homelessness (SCAH) – Virtual Flag Day – Saturday 11th September 2021

'The times they are a -changin' go the words of the 1960's song...and they are! Fewer and fewer people are using cash...so SCAH has decided to have a virtual 'flag day' (centred around 11th September) this year to help raise funds so that it can continue its work with the poor and homeless in the Solihull area.

Homelessness and poverty in Solihull? Surely not...we all live in a prosperous borough, don't we? And yet by the end of August 2021 SCAH had assisted more than 140 adults (with 26 associated children) who were homeless or suffering poverty for a variety of reasons - domestic abuse, relationship breakdowns, family break-ups, dependency issues and release from prison to name just some. The numbers of adults assisted has increased by 13% compared with the same period last year...so the 'times are a-changin'.... more people than ever need SCAH's support.
