## Luke 19 v 1 - 10 Zaccheus

- U.1-2 He entered Jericho and was passing through. A man was there named Zaccheus; he was a chief tax collector and was rich.
  - Pause on your walk and think of the place that you live in. Maybe your walk has taken you past some of the offices and buildings. Try to come up with a list of all the businesses and services that have influence and authority in your town. Use stones or twigs to create a map/picture.
- V. 3-4 Zaccheus could not see as he was short. So he climbed a tree. Look around and find the highest place you can – perhaps climb a tree. Look down and see what you can see below. Look carefully at the things by your feet – what detail can you see when you really look? Notice the patterns and textures, variety and colour.
- U V 5-6 Jesus looked up and said, "come down for I must come to your house today. So he hurried down and was happy to welcome him."

  Have a game of tig or stick in the mud together. Jesus wanted to be with Zaccheus and was welcomed into his home, his family. Enjoy belonging to your family and have fun being together.
- V 7 -8 Zaccheus said, "half of my possessions I will give to the poor". Zaccheus was changed by meeting Jesus and began to think of others and how he could help them. Collect leaves, sticks or petals and other natural materials and make a picture with them for others to enjoy as they pass by.
- U V 9-10 Jesus said Zaccheus "too is a Son of Abraham".

Think about how everyone is welcome in the Kingdom of God. You might know a song to sing to celebrate God's love for everyone. Try running in circles, making each circle bigger and bigger and then smaller and smaller until only you are in the circle. God's love is big enough for everyone yet close enough for you to know it too.
