

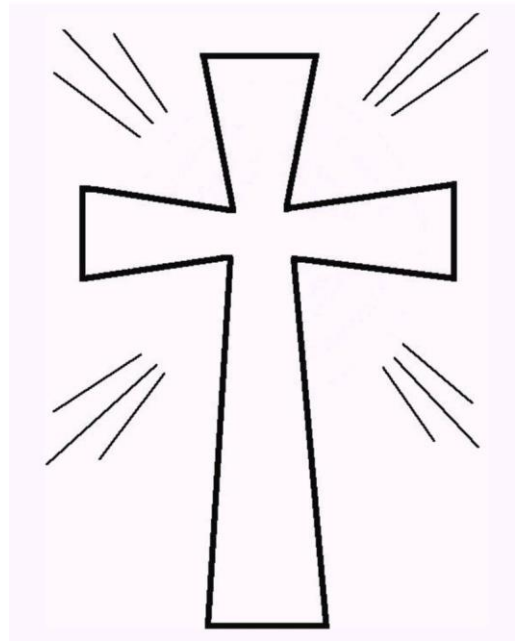

“The Easter Story”

On Good Friday, Jesus was nailed to a cross. The disciples placed Jesus into a tomb, and rolled a stone in front of it. After 3 days, Mary went to the tomb to visit Jesus' body, but he was not there. The tomb was empty. When she went to leave, Jesus spoke to her. Jesus had risen from the dead.



Thinking Points: The Easter Story holds a lot of mystery – can you think of a time when you have been unsure about what's been going on? How did you feel?

Good Friday brought pain and suffering, but 3 days later we have hope. When you're sad, scared, confused, do you turn to God for hope and reassurance? You might like to discuss times when you have or haven't, and why, with someone.

Why do you think the Easter Story is important?

Activity: Write an acrostic poem about the Easter Story, where you use each letter of the word “EASTER” to start each line.
